# Communities Nucșoara

Nucsoara is the first rural community we reached. Now we are working with 82 children and still growing, with the addition of new children and younger siblings.



# Evaluations and personalised learning plans

Born in an unfavourable environment, with little chance of entering the educational system on time, our children have limited opportunities to reach a better life. Getting them into school and keeping them there is a significant challenge. Most of the children struggle to keep up at school, falling further behind each year. To address this educational gap, we created personalised educational plans based on a basic skills evaluation of each child and a curriculum tailored strictly to their needs.



# Preparing for the National Evaluation

Moving from one cycle of learning to another is a vulnerable moment for children already predisposed to abandoning school. Our first aim with the tutoring programme for the 8th grade is to encourage and support the children to continue with school after they finish 8th grade.

To enter high school, they need to write the challenging "National Evaluation." In 2022 we prepared a comprehensive plan for the children, including initial evaluations, a realistic curriculum, and regular tutoring visits to the communities to complement the weekly online tutoring.



# **Ophthalmology caravan**

The ophthalmology caravan was in high demand in 2022. We returned to our communities (Nucșoara, Lerești and Ferentari) and in addition, we visited 5 new communities (from Brașov to Teleorman).

For the majority of the children, this was their first eye check-up. As always, we discovered children with undiagnosed vision problems and we helped them select frames and prepared glasses for them. This year we also obtained some new equipment, including a mobile device for checking the vision of younger children. Catching vision problems early can help ensure proper treatment and prevent complications.

# Yearly medical check-ups

In 2022 we increased our health-care support thanks to a new partnership with one of the best-known private medical networks in Romania, Regina Maria. With their support, we offered a complete set of blood tests and a pediatric check-up for each child, and where needed, additional investigations and surgeries.

For most of our children, this was their first time to have blood collected for analysis, and we started the process with some apprehension. The children surpassed our expectations – and those of the experienced nurses – with their courage and patience.

And that's how the blouse with the "sewn at Casa Buna" label was created.






# **Groceries distribution**

As always, we bought new clothing and shoes, because we know how happy and proud any child feels when they go to school with brand new clothing.

But we didn't think it was enough for the clothing to be new: we also made sure it was colourful, warm, stylish and durable. When it came time to try on the clothing, each child choose their favourite colour and the best-fitting size. None of our clients left Casa Buna's boutique unsatisfied!

# **School supplies**

At the start of September our volunteers gathered at Casa Buna for our annual Swedish buffet of school supplies. Only this year it was not really Swedish, but rather Austrian: a large part of the backpacks and school supplies came from Vienna, through the support of the good people at Stepic CEE Charity and Raiffeisen Bank.

Within minutes of the delivery truck stopping at Casa Buna's gate, our gang of volunteers started shuttling the supplies into the house, sorting them, and carefully preparing and packing each backpack for its final destination: the arms of the children. And like every year, our biggest joy was seeing the pride of the smallest children when they received their first school backpack.




But we have to start somewhere. We have the use of two apartments at the moment, purchased by Valeriu and renovated by Marian. One of them is already in use by a family in need.







Few, but hearty and completely dedicated to the cause, juggling their jobs, families and other daily obligations, they found time to help us accomplish all our missions, whenever we called for help.








# Financial resources invested (RON)

## Bonus - Where we screwed up in 2022

### Apprenticeship program

In 2022 we paused our apprenticeship program due to the lack of a clear strategy to attract and retain the teenagers from vulnerable communities.

### Casa Buna branches

Although our mission is to reach more communities in need, we didn't yet finalize a framework to help other volunteer groups create their own local Casa Buna to support local vulnerable communities.

### Teen moms and teens at risk

We didn't find a way to help vulnerable teenage girls build a better future. We didn't manage to build a sex ed or family planning program to guide them.

### **Building the Nucsoara cabin**

We were too optimistic about the time needed to obtain all of the required authorisations to start building the cabin.

### Teamwork

We are brilliant at working independently but we still have a way to go when it comes to teamwork, strengthening the team and motivating each other.

#### **Overload**

On many occasions we took on more activities than we could handle, which led to long working hours and fatigue.

#### **Back injuries**

From carrying washing machines to hours hunched over the computer, most of the team had back pains this year. We need to learn to take better care of ourselves.

### Effort - impact
